

From Mason Williams' archives:

"I came up with this bumper sticker in 1990. I saw that the Republicans, who used to be financially conservative, had become the big spenders in government.

2004 was an election year full of mixed messages and mixed signals. The Republicans talked about Kerry's mixed message/mixed signal, but how about their mixed message? The entire Bush Administration is a mixed message. The big mixed message comes from the Republicans! They've become jingoists, gung-ho on bankrupting the country.
